- Support the integration of courses like “Universal Human Values” into AICTE-approved syllabi.

- Organise Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) to train faculty members in value education and ensure effective delivery.

- To ensure proper teaching of UHV-I of the Student Induction Program (SIP) and UHV-II of 2nd year, through oriented faculty members.
- To develop the UHV teachers through advanced UHV FDPs and motivate other faculty members and students to attend the initial level of UHV workshops.
