



**Minutes of the Academic Council Meeting held on
29.09.2023 at 10.30AM**

The academic council meeting was held on 29th September 2023, Friday via online mode using Teams platform. The Principal of the college & Chairman Academic Council extended a warm welcome to the members present. Principal introduced Director, Academic Planning, JNTUK, Dr K Venkata Reddy garu, to the other members of the academic Council. Dean Academics presented the agenda items.

Item No. I: Confirmation of the minutes of previous Academic council meeting held on 10.08.2023.

- ★ It was resolved to confirm and ratify the minutes of previous Academic council meeting held on 10.08.2023.

Item No. II: To present and ratify UR23 academic regulations for B.Tech regular students admitted from the academic year 2023-24 onwards and Lateral Entry students admitted from the AY 2024-25 onwards.

- ★ It was resolved to approve and ratify UR23 academic regulations for B.Tech regular students admitted from the academic year 2023-24 onwards and Lateral Entry students admitted from the AY 2024-25 onwards. (Annexure I)
- ★ UR23 regulations are framed in tune with JNTUK with slight modifications as stated below
 - **Practical Evaluation:** Semester End Evaluation for practical courses shall be for 70 marks, conducted by the concerned

Laboratory teacher and an external examiner in the subject from the same department.

- **Promotion Rules:** The following academic requirements must be satisfied in addition to the attendance requirements mentioned in section 16 of UR23 academic Regulations
 - i) A student shall be promoted from first year to second year if he/she fulfils the minimum attendance requirement as per the Institute / university norms.
 - ii) A student will be promoted from II to III year if he/she fulfils the academic requirement of securing 40% of the credits (any decimal fraction should be rounded off to lower digit) up to the subjects that have been studied up to IV semester.
 - iii) A student shall be promoted from III year to IV year if he/she fulfils the academic requirements of securing 40% of the credits (any decimal fraction should be rounded off to lower digit) in the subjects that have been studied up to VI semester.

- And in case a student is detained for want of credits for a particular academic year by ii) or iii) above, the student may make up the credits through supplementary examinations and only after securing the required credits he /she shall be permitted to join in the V semester or VII semester respectively as the case may be.

- When a B.Tech regular student is detained due to lack of credits/shortage of attendance he/she may be re-admitted when the semester is offered after fulfilment of academic regulations. In such situations, he/she shall be in the academic regulations into which he/she is re-admitted in case of I year. But in case of 2nd, 3rd and 4th year he/she shall be in academic regulations in to which he/she took admission.

- For B.Tech Lateral Entry scheme, when a student is detained due to lack of credits/shortage of attendance he/she may be re-admitted when the semester is offered after fulfilment of academic regulations. In such situations, he/she shall be in the academic regulations into which he/she is re-admitted in case of 2nd year. But in case of 3rd and 4th year he/she shall be in academic regulations in to which he/she took admission.

Item No. III: To present and ratify the minutes of recent BOS meetings.

- ★ It was resolved to approve and ratify the minutes of recent BoS meetings held in the month of September 2023.
 - Minutes of the BoS meetings have covered B.Tech Course structure and Common syllabus for I Year under UR 23 regulations as per JNTUK / APSICHE guidelines.

Item No. IV: To present and approve the course structure and I year syllabus for B.Tech AI&DS, AI&ML, CSE, ECE, EEE, IT and ME programs under UR23 regulations.

- ★ It was resolved to approve the course structure and I year syllabus for B.Tech AI&DS, AI&ML, CSE, ECE, EEE, IT and ME programs under UR23 regulations.(Annexure II)

Item No.V: To present and approve I B.Tech Academic Calendar for the academic year 2023-24 in tune with JNTUK / APSICHE guidelines.

- ★ Members have approved the I B.Tech Academic Calendar for the academic year 2023-24 which is in tune with JNTUK / APSICHE guidelines.

Item No. VI: Any other item with the permission of Chair.

- ★ Members have noted that the admissions status of the institute is 95.8%. Out of 432 seats, 414 seats were filled for the academic Year 2023-24 in convenor quota.

- ★ University authorities Dr B Bala Krishna & Dr K Venkata Reddy have suggested to exercise autonomy where ever required under the purview of JNTUK guidelines.
- ★ Mr.K V Ravi Kumar, external member of academic council from Industry gave an offer to the faculty of the institute for Industrial visit & training program on latest equipment.
- ★ There was a discussion on Internship evaluation procedure proposed by Mr Narendra Kumar Saranam External member (Industry) of the academic council and it was resolved to follow the guidelines given by the university.

The meeting was interactive and the Principal expressed vote of thanks to all the honourable members of the academic council for their contribution, cooperation, support and highly valuable suggestions towards shaping the future of the Institution.
