03	Minutes of the previous meeting held on 07 <sup>th</sup> March, 2025 are confirmed and accepted by the members.

The principal has conveyed the members that due to the establishment of the new deemed to be universities and delay in second and third round counseling schedule are the main reasons, further assurance given to the members, that other reasons for drop in admissions are being identified and measures will be taken to resolve them.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <u>The academic and other activities of the institution since the last meeting of the governing body:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ A total of 102 papers by our teachers are published in international; SCOPUS; UGC recognized; SCI; Springer conferences and other publications.</li> <li>➤ <u>Workshops/training program attended by faculty members as participant:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ 25 teachers have attended to various advanced programs conducted in prestigious institutions like IITs; NITs; and other reputed universities including JNTUK Kakinada.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <u>Seminars, Workshops and training programs organized:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ The college has conducted 4 programs on Drones; Data Science with Python; SCILAB; and Usher Interface with flutter by all departments, 365 participants have attended and benefitted.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <u>Improvement of qualification by faculty members (awarded PhD):</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Two of our staff members Mr Siva Kumar Babu Civil; and Mr E Ramakrishna Reddy ECE have got Ph D degrees since the last meeting.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <u>Staff members pursuing Ph D:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ 20 of our staff members are pursuing Ph D in various Universities.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ <u>Ph D pursuing under the guidance of our staff members:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Our senior staff members are guiding 14 students of various universities for their Ph D degree.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- M. Tech/Ph D awarded under the guidance of our staff members:
- ✓ One student has received Ph D degree and 4 students have got M. Tech degree under the guidance of our staff members.
- Online certification course attended by staff:
- ✓ 19 teaching staff members have attended, successfully completed and awarded certificates on elite level on cloud computing; machine learning, IOT, data science for engineers etc.
- Online certification course attended by students:
- ✓ 75 of our students have attended online certification courses organized by EDUSKILL; NPTEL-SWAYAM on cyber security; and Introduction to IOT.
- Participation of students in seminars/symposia and paper presentation:
- ✓ 10 students have presented papers on engineers day; EPITEMICON-2025
- Enrolment to higher studies of 2025 graduates:
- ✓ 27 students have got admissions and pursuing masters in abroad and in reputed universities in India.
- Students training & certifications:
- ✓ Our second; third and final year students totaling 174 have undergone training and got certificates from APSSDC; and EDU SKILLS,
- Students internship:
- ✓ All final year students of all branches have attended physical and online internship in reputed organizations like Brain O Vision; EDU SKILLS; APSSDC; Electrical substations; and South Central Railways, after their third year second semester.
- Sport:
- ✓ Our students D Jhānsi ECE and S Rani ECE have got 1<sup>st</sup> place in JNTUK central zone women tournaments and have represented JNTUK at national level JUDO in Bhopal.
