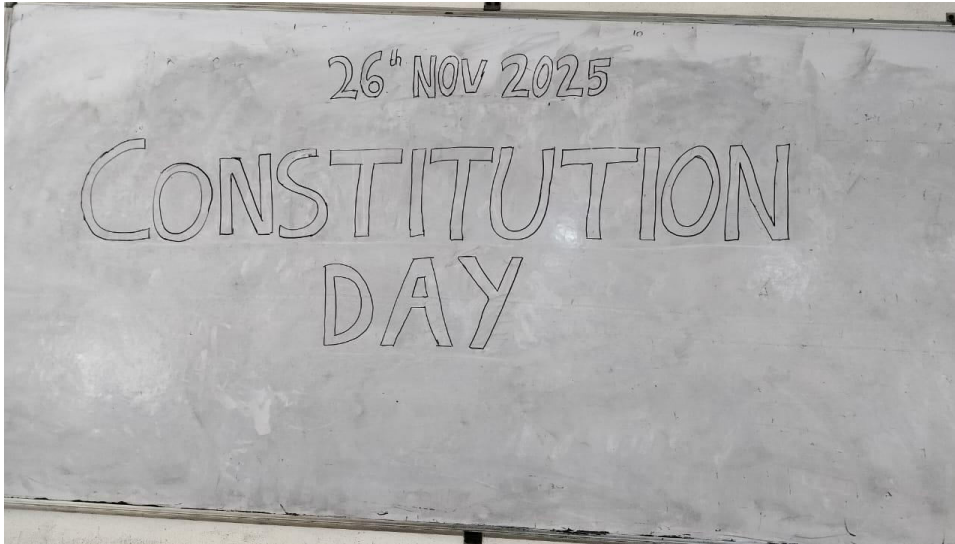
## Conclusion

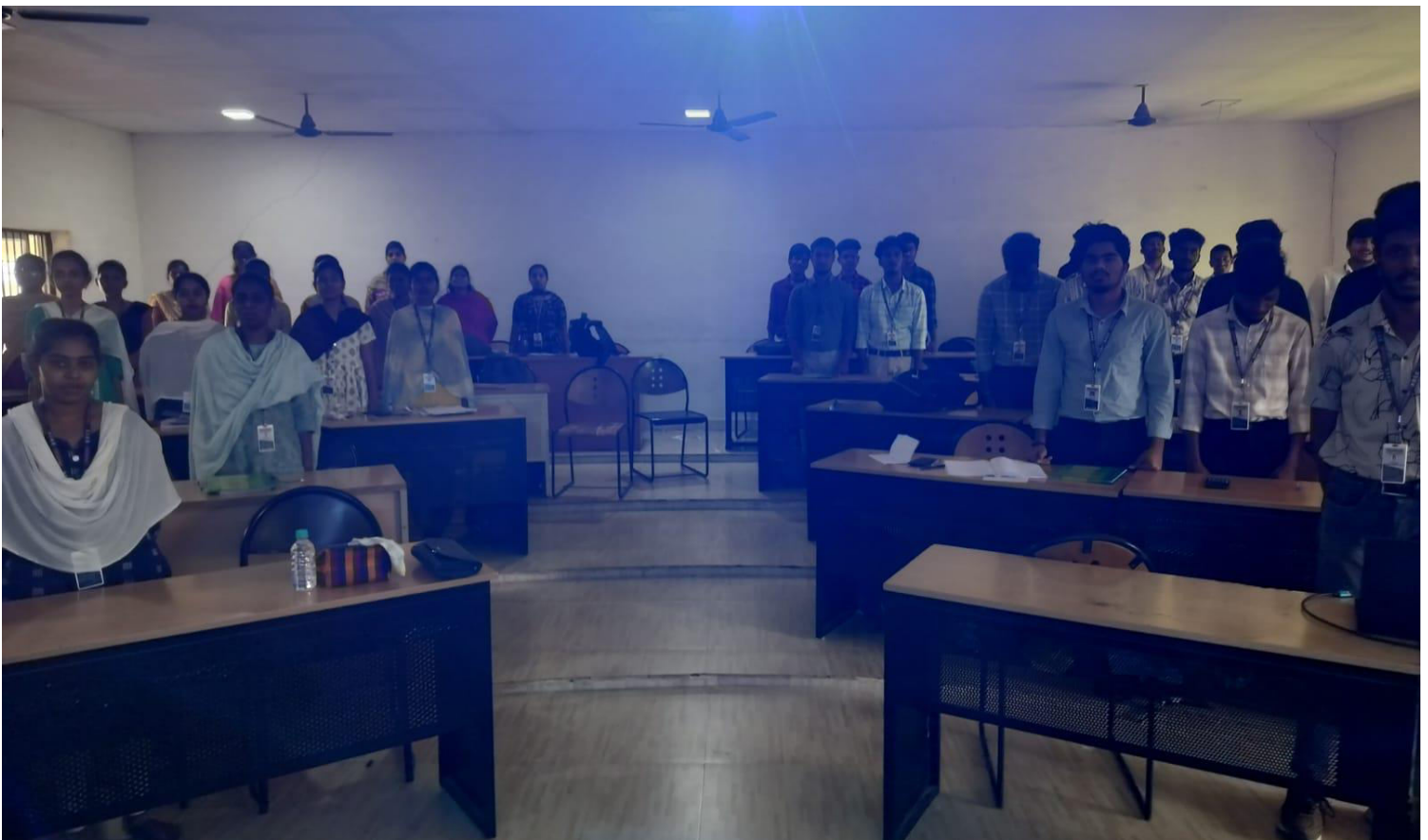
